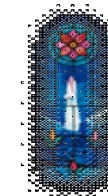

Birmingham Churches Night Shelter: at St. Anne's Presbytery and Church:

We welcome more volunteers to support this project helping some of the homeless in the city.

Please note the dates. 2017 Dates for us to provide night shelter for 12 homeless - Monday evenings from 20 February 2017 for six weeks through to Monday 27 March 2017. While there will be a core group of volunteers responsible for each Monday evening/Tuesday morning we need people to meet and greet the guests at 7pm, to prepare the beds, to help with preparing and serving food, to wash up. Holocaust Memorial Day Birmingham will be commemorating National Holocaust Memorial Day on 22 January 2017 with the theme "How Can Life Go On?". The ceremony will be held in Birmingham's Council House and is free. Doors open at 1pm when members of the public will be invited to light a candle of remembrance. Holocaust Memorial Day commemorates the victims and survivors of the Holocaust and Nazi persecutions as well as other worldwide genocides and as such provides a significant opportunity to learn lessons and apply them to the present day to create a safer, better future.
