Each year the KYT run the UKs only Lifeteen Summer Camp at Alton Castle. Lifeteen is an organisation that we have partnered for the last 7 years to deliver this sacramentally centred camp for 12 to 18 year olds. Over the past couple of years demand has grown so much that we now run two camps each summer. We can take 125 young people each week as well as a committed team of 35 young adults. The camp takes place this year from 4th to 8th and 11th to 15th August.
