Fatima House is a collaborative project whose foundation partners are Father Hudson's Care (working name of Father Hudson's Society), the Catholic Archdiocese of Birmingham, The Columban Missionaries, St Anne's Parish, Digbeth and Caritas Archdiocese of Birmingham.

The aims of the project are to:
provide hospitality and welcome for vulnerable female asylum seekers who have no recourse to public funds; provide short-term accommodation, meeting residents' basic needs and providing them with safe shelter; collaborate with key local agencies who will refer residents to Fatima House; support each resident in the effort to move forward as soon as possible to a maximum period of 6 months, unless in extenuating circumstances
