What is it Like??

Yorkshire man, Sean Bean, best known for his roles in the historical drama *Sharpe* and fantasy series *Game of Thrones*, is to play an northern Catholic priest in Jimmy Mc.Govern's new BBC1 prime time drama series, *Broken* to be aired later this Spring.

Bean was mentored by Jesuit Denis Blackledge for his part as Father Michael Kerrigan, and his fictional parish of St. Nick's was shot at Blackledge's parish of St. Francis Xavier's in Liverpool.

Speaking to the magazine *Jesuits and Friends*, father Denis said the production team wanted to know what it was like to be a Catholic priest working in an urban environment in the early 21st century.

Fatima Shepherds to be canonised on centenary of apparitions.

Pope Francis will canonise two of the three children, siblings Francisco and Jacinta Marto, who witnessed the apparitions of Our Lady in Fatima 100 years ago. The ceremony will take place on the 13th May, the centenary of the first apparition, during Francis' visit to the shrine.

Francisco, who died aged ten in 1919 and Jacinta, who died a year later, aged nine will become the youngest children, apart from martyrs, to be recognised as saints by the church, once they are canonised.
