Vocations to the Permanent Diaconate: The Archbishop wishes to give greater publicity to the Permanent Diaconate and has produced a leaflet summarising the main features of this ordained Ministry. The leaflet gives information regarding the procedure for prospective candidates, who believe they may have a calling, to apply for formation in the Archdiocese. Copies are available at the back of church and your prayers are requested for more vocations to this diaconate, to the priesthood and religious life.

The [Art of Dying Well](http://www.artofdyingwell.org) is based in the Catholic tradition but is open to all. Launched on All Saints Day, it features real-life stories about the highs and lows of dealing with the final journey. Professionals in palliative care, ethics, chaplaincy and history have informed the site content.
